Your gift makes a big difference

Giving a one-off gift can make an immediate impact to our fundraising and be convenient and tax-efficient for the donor. A regular gift, whether monthly or annually, can help allow the School to plan for the future and encourage wide participation across the Tonbridge School community.

We are enormously grateful for the support of all our donors who have given a one-off gift or pledged to give on a regular basis. It does not matter how small or large, every gift makes a difference and brings us closer to achieving 'Excellence for All'.

Tax-efficient giving

The tables below shows how Gift Aid can greatly increase the total donation that the School receives. They also show how tax relief can reduce the net cost of the donation to you. For example, if as a 45% rate tax-payer you donate £10,000, the School receives £12,500 thanks to the 25% Gift Aid amount. The tax relief you receive reduces the donation 'cost' from £10,000 to £6,875.

Legacy giving

As a registered charity, all legacies made to the Foundation are exempt from UK Inheritance and Capital Gains Taxes. Under current rules, if you leave 10% or more of your chargeable net estate to charity, the Inheritance Tax (IHT) rate on the whole of your taxable estate is reduced from 40% to 36%. By way of example, if a UK testator has an estate of £500,000, a donation of £17,500 diminishes the remaining estate by only £4200*.
